Rise & Shine Program Development

High Level Outcomes:

- Held a two day volunteer gathering with 100 First Nations women and girls in the Kimberley
- 1,700 hours of volunteering achieved at the November Roundtable 2023.
- Initial program design
- Initial service mapping spreadsheet

Key Learnings:

- Kimberley Aboriginal women and girls are excited to provide and receive mentoring
- The concept of volunteering for our people is complex
- Health, wellbeing and strong culture is critical
- Further co-design is needed
