About customised volunteer role

The customised volunteer role is tailored from individual tasks to meet business needs and the interests of prospective volunteers. It aims to eliminate barriers for people with disabilities, allowing them to volunteer and build skills at their own pace. Tasks are selected from existing roles and defined in the position description, with the goal of assessing the volunteer's capacity and exploring future tasks as they grow more comfortable.

Support needs

This section can include whether the volunteer attends with a support worker, needs information in a different format, or has any other requirements or restrictions that could be barriers to volunteering.
